ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING NEW LOBBYING RULES

The Office of the City Clerk adopted new rules which became effective on November 4th, 2015. The rules replace chapter 1 of title 51 of the Rules of the City of New York ("RCNY") in its entirety and include the amendments mandated by Local Law 129 of 2013.

Specifically, the rules:

- Establish criteria for requesting advisory opinions;
- Set forth the procedure for enrolling in e-Lobbyist;
- Define the roles of principal officer, designee and compliance officer;
- Provide requirements for retainers and authorization letters;
- Include a process to deactivate statements of registration;
- Set forth the procedures for obtaining a waiver of late filing penalties;
- Establish Lobbying Bureau enforcement procedures; and
- Create an amnesty program.
